Molecular Physics Special Issue: HRMS Stabia 09

Molecular Physics will be producing a special issue dedicated to high resolution molecular spectroscopy, linked to the HRMS Stabia 09 meeting, to be edited by the Chairman of the Editors of Molecular Physics, Professor Tim Softley (Oxford). This will not be a proceedings of the conference – rather, the special issue will contain original research papers linked to material presented at the conference in posters and talks. These papers may also enlarge, to a considerable extent, on the material presented at Stabia 09. The papers will be treated as regular submissions and refereed in the normal way; their content should match the high standards of originality and significance on which papers are normally judged.

Professor Softley will be attending the conference, and he will be pleased to answer any questions about the special issue.

There will be two closing dates for submission:

- September 30th 2009
- January 31st 2010

The first deadline is intended for papers that are essentially ready for submission at the time of the conference; the second is for work still in development at that time. There will be at least one separate issue of the journal in hard copy associated with each of these closing dates. The first is likely to be published in hard copy in January 2010, the second in mid 2010. However, papers will be published individually online with a unique DOI number as soon as the proofs are finalised.
